Womack keynote speaker at UNC-Wilmington

WILMINGTON, North Carolina – UNCW head baseball coach Mark Scalf has announced It will also be a sold-out event at the Burney Center on Saturday, February 1, 2014 for the UNCW spring baseball banquet as 13-year Major League veteran and World Series winner Tony Womack will serve as the featured speaker.

"It's a pleasure to have Tony Womack as our featured speaker for the Spring Training Banquet," said Scalf. "Tony worked his way to the major league level through dedication and hard work. He had a very successful career and helped teams win in any fashion he could."

Womack played 13 seasons in the major leagues for seven teams, including the Pittsburgh Pirates and Arizona Diamondbacks for five seasons apiece. While with the Diamond Backs, he helped the organization to its first World Series championship in 2001 against the New York Yankees. Womack also appeared in the 2004 Fall Classic with the Cardinals.
